# What is Elder abuse?

Elder abuse can take many forms, including:

- Physical violence
- · Humbugging an Elder for money, such as their pension or stealing their cards.
- · Sexual violence

## How does abuse affect our Elders?

Abuse can leave Elders feeling helpless, scared, and unvalued. It can make them feel like they are no longer important to their family or community, a devastating loss for those who have spent their lives guiding and supporting others.
